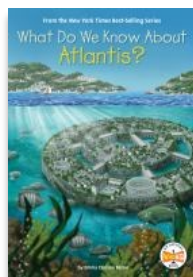


What Do We Know About Atlantis?

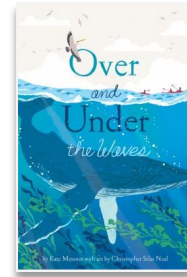


Over and Under the Waves
