Minutes of the Regular Library Board Meeting Chanhassen Library August 8, 2023 at 4:30 p.m.

Call to Order: Frank Foss called the meeting to order at 4:31 p.m. A quorum was met. Charles Teh arrived at 4:40 and assumed the Chair at that time

Approval of Agenda:

• Jan Melchert / Alan Krueger moved to approve the agenda of the Library Board meeting. Motion approved unanimously.

Approval of Minutes of Meeting:

• Gwen Kuhrt / Jan Melchert moved to approve the minutes of the July 11, 2023 Library Board meeting, noting a correction to the time of adjournment as 5:40 (not 4:40). Motion with correction approved unanimously.

Public Comment / Introduction of Visitors:

- Laurie Hokkanen, Chanhassen City Manager provided an update about the City of Chanhassen.
 - o Distributed several handouts
 - o Note about work "in the background" that is in progress although not readily apparent.
 - o Concept plan discussed for new building for City Hall, law enforcement, senior center, and other park amenities. Renderings may be available around October.
 - The plan should provide a positive impact on parking for library patrons.
 - o Chanhassen Cinema project discussed
 - o Pedestrian crosswalk issues
 - o Q&A
 - How will project impact library services during construction?
 We can expect some disruption but it should be minimal.
 - Question & answer about hotel being converted
 - Will there be a new grocery store?
 There may be two groceries that are interested in opening but no specifics at this time
 - Follow up about pedestrian crosswalk: Could there be a tunnel?
 Answer Information is known from other cities that tunnels are expensive and therefore not a likely solution for pedestrian crosswalk issues in Chanhassen.

 - o *Erin Busse* noted that the book had been on a display shelf at the Waconia Library from which a child could easily reach and look at the book

 - Ouestion about circulation stats on this title.
 - o Question about resolution. When will the Board reply?
