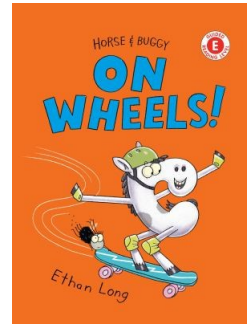


On Wheels!

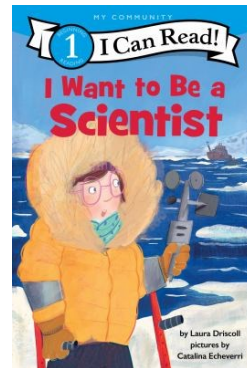

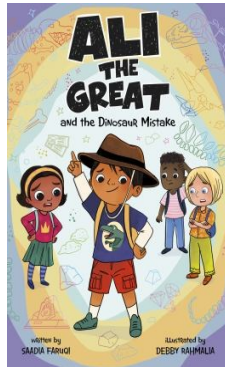


Ali the Great and the Dinosaur Mistake

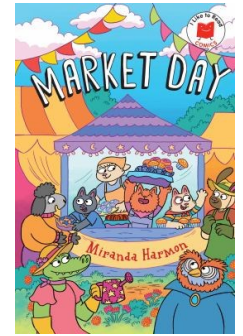

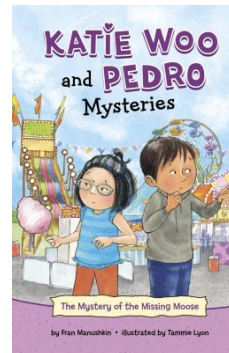

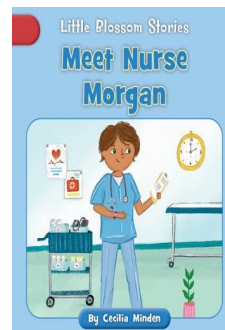


Meet Nurse Morgan
